TOURNAMENT RULES

These tournament rules are in addition to an overrule the general rules, as per the Vade-mecum 2019 of the French Golf Federation.

I – ELIGIBILITY

This tournament is reserved to amateur players, men and women, licensed with their Golf Association. All players should give with their inscription a medical certificate of non-counter indication to play golf.

II – CONDITIONS OF PLAY

The tournament consists in a **72 holes single Stroke play**, 18 holes per day. A cut will apply after 36 holes. **Forecast schedule is as in the table below.** The gross total of the four rounds will determine the position of the players. Players are split in 1 "Grand Prix Elite" (Men's and Ladies' Biarritz Cup) and 2 other tournaments:

➤ **Men's Biarritz Cup:** 120 players maximum selected: first players ranked in top 2500 WAGR, then as per French Order of Merit, then increasing order of index which should be $\leq 1,4$, (**CAT WAGR = C and CAT MA 2020 = 0**).

➤ **Ladies Biarritz Cup:** 36 players minimum selected: first players ranked in top 2500 WWAGR, then as per French Order of Merit, then increasing order of index which should be $\leq 4,4$, (**CAT WAGR = C and CAT MA 2020 = 0**).

➤ **Town Cup:** 132 players (111 men and 21 ladies), 50% selected in the order of Entry Forms received, 50% selected with increasing order of index which should be from **1.5 to 7,4** for men and from **0 to 12,0** for ladies.

➤ **Men's Trophy:** 150 players, 2/3 selected in the order of Entry Forms received, 1/3 selected with increasing order of index from **7,5 to 16,0**.

Note 1: The index to be considered will be the player's index on June 14th 2020.

Note 2: The "French Order of Merit" will be the "French Order of Merit" on June 1st 2020.

Note 3: A player can play only one tournament. If a player is in Biarritz Cup waiting list and also registered in Town Cup, he will imperatively notified to the Committee his choice of tournament played before June 24rd 2020.

Note 4: Wild Cards: For players who do not respond to the above criterias The League of Nouvelle-Aquitaine will get 14 wild-cards for the players of the Biarritz Cup Men and Women (included in the 156 participants), wild-cards will be received before June 14th 2020 midnight. Moreover, the tournament Committee will get 20 wild-cards for the players of the Town Cup Men and Women included in the 132 participants and 30 for those of the Trophée included the 150 participants.

IV – ENTRY FORMS AND REGISTRATION FEES

➤ **Entry forms must be sent and fees paid (secured payment) on the Web: www.biarriz-cup.com from April 07th at 2 pm and before June 14th 2020 midnight.**

For players of Men's and Ladies' Biarritz Cup, last 56 of Town Cup and 40 of Trophy, they will receive a confirmation after the registration closing date June 14th 2020 midnight, their fees will be refunded if they are not in the final starting field.

➤ **Registration fees are:** Biarritz Cup: 120 € for adult players, 60 € for players born in 1995 or after (25 years old and less) and 30 € for players born in 2002 or less (18 years old or less). Town Cup & Trophy: 190 € for adult players, 95 € for players born in 1995 or after (25 years old or less) and 50 € for players born in 2002 or after (18 years old or less).

➤ **Practice round reserved to Men's and Ladies' Biarritz Cup only from Sunday 5/07 to Wednesday 8/07 during afternoon. To book practice round, call the Biarritz Golf Club two days before.**

List of registered and waiting list will be available on the website at latest on June 29th.

V – REGISTRATION

Players must register **from Friday 3rd of July at 2.00 pm and before noon on the day before** their first round. Failure to do so will imply the player withdraws from the competition. He will be replaced by the first player on the waiting list.

VI – ATTIRE

Correct clothes, in accordance with golf traditions, must be worn on the course. As an example, wearing blue jeans, shorts, tee shirts or tank tops are not allowed.

Warning: caddies must also wear correct clothes and are not allowed to wear metal spike shoes, competitor might be disqualified. The wearing of a polo of your club or a polo of Biarritz Cup is asked for the prize-giving.

VI I- WITHDRAWAL

Withdrawal must be notified at the latest 2 days before the first round. Otherwise, the registration fees will not be returned.

VIII – AWARDS

Gross score prevails on net score. Gross and net awards cannot be cumulated.

- **In Men's and Ladies' Biarritz Cup:** the 3 best gross scores will be awarded in each category.
- **In Town Cup:** the 3 best gross scores for men and 1 for ladies will receive a Prize.
- **In the Trophy:** the 2 best gross scores and the best net score will receive a prize.

In each category, the name of the winner will be engraved on the Tournament Cup.

In case of an undue absence at the prize giving ceremony, the prize will be given to the next player in the placing.

IX – SETTLING TIES

➤ **1 :** In case of a tie for the last qualifying place after every qualifying round, and after the 4 rounds, in case of tie for the first place in gross score, it will be decided in a **“Hole by hole”** play off which will be played just after the last player has returned his score card.

➤ **2 :** For all other places, it will be decided according to the best score of the last 18 holes, and successively the best 9, 6, 3, 1 holes; if the tie still remains, will be considered the best score hole by hole from the last one to the first one.

➤ **Furthermore** the tournament Committee is entitled to substitute method 2 instead of “hole by hole” in case of impossibility to play a “Hole by hole” play off or to complete it (in this last case, players qualified during the play off will remain qualified, only last remaining places will be decided according to method 2).

X – STARTING TIMES

Starting times will be available at Biarritz Golf Course the previous evening by 7p.m. for the following day. In case of exceptional conditions, the Tournament Committee is entitled to make any change in order to ensure the smooth running of the Biarritz Cup Competition.

XI – BAD WEATHER OR EXCEPTIONAL CONDITIONS

If the tournament is stopped because of weather conditions or any other exceptional conditions, a round being started should not be cancelled but finished even the day after if conditions allow.

If it is not possible to finish last round, positions will be determined only by completed rounds played.

XII – TOURNAMENT COMMITTEE

The Tournament Committee can modify or cancel the whole or any part of the tournament, modify the number of players (more or less), cancel one or more rounds, modify date of rounds. Names of Tournament Committee members will be posted on the official board.

XIII – OFFICIAL BOARD

It is the player's responsibility to know the information and last minute changes, concerning the present tournament rules, decided by the Tournament Committee and posted on the official board.
